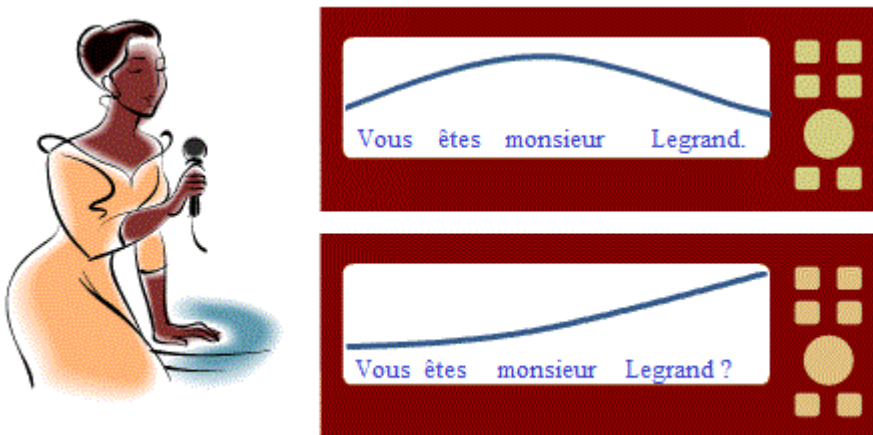
L'interrogation : l'intonation de la voix. *Interrogation: the intonation of the voice*

Construction

To ask a question, you can simply use the intonation of the voice: you use the same construction as an affirmative sentence, but you raise your voice at the end of the sentence.

Phrase affirmative : Vous êtes monsieur Legrand. *Affirmative sentence: You are Mr. Legrand. (voice going down)*

Phrase interrogative : Vous êtes monsieur Legrand ? *Interrogative sentence: You are Mr. Legrand? (voice going up)*



Exemples

- Vous êtes d'accord ?
• *Do you agree?*
- Vous aimez Paris ?
• *Are you from Paris?*
- Vous parlez anglais ?
• *Do you speak English?*
- Monsieur Legrand habite à Montréal ?
• *Does Mr. Legrand live in Montreal?*
- Tu aimes le cinéma ?
• *Do you like movies?*
- Marc aime chanter ?
• *Does Marc like singing?*



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
