Introduction



Sam is taller than his sister.



The white egg is the biggest and the red egg is the smallest.

Definition and use

We use comparative adjectives to compare two things or people.

We use superlative adjectives to compare more than two things or people.

Construction

The construction usually depends on the number of syllables.

Comparatives:

One-syllable	adjective + 'er' + 'than' colder than	Sweden is colder than France.
Two-syllables and ending in a consonant and 'y'	adjective + 'er' + 'than' busier than	I'm busier than my boss.
More than two syllables	'more' + adjective + 'than' more expensive than	Cars are more expensive than motorbikes.
