If you win this game you will play in the championship match.

## **Definition**

The first conditional refers to events that are likely to happen in the future.

The result is not definite but is, at least, possible.

## Construction

If + present + future

## **Uses**

Use	Examples
Prediction	If the train is delayed, I'm going to be late for my meeting
Plans	We're having a barbeque on Sunday if it doesn't rain.

Logical conclusion	If a customer calls, the telephone will ring.
Exchange	If you get me to the airport quickly, I'll give you a big tip.
Offers	If your car isn't working, I can help you.
Contingency	If it rains, we'll go to the cinema instead
