01:00	1:00 a.m.	one (a.m.) or one o'clock
02:00	2:00 a.m.	two (a.m.) or two o'clock
03:00	3:00 a.m.	three (a.m.) or two o'clock, etc.
12:00		twelve (noon/midday)
13:00	1:00 p.m.	one (p.m.) thirteen
14:00	2:00 p.m.	two (p.m.) fourteen
00:00	12:00	twelve (midnight) twenty-four ❌

12:05	12:05 a.m./p.m.	twelve 'o' five (a.m./p.m.)
12:10	12:10 a.m./p.m.	twelve ten (a.m./p.m.)
12:15	12:15 a.m./p.m.	twelve fifteen (a.m./p.m.)
12:20	12:20 a.m./p.m.	twelve twenty (a.m./p.m.)
12:25	12:25 a.m./p.m.	twelve twenty-five (a.m./p.m.)
12:30	12:30 a.m./p.m.	twelve thirty (a.m./p.m.)
12:35	12:35 a.m./p.m.	twelve thirty-five (a.m./p.m.)
12:40	12:40 a.m./p.m.	twelve forty (a.m./p.m.)
12:45	12:45 a.m./p.m.	twelve forty-five (a.m./p.m.)
12:50	12:50 a.m./p.m.	twelve fifty (a.m./p.m.)
