Possessive adjectives are for possession.

Personal pronoun Possessive adjective

Uses

The possessive adjective is in relation to the **possessor.**



This is Jeremy. **His** mother is a teacher and **his** father is an engineer.



This is Sophie. **Her** mother is Dutch and **her** father is French.

Examples



Hello. **My** name is John Brown. **My** name is Sophie

Williams.



Welcome to the Paris Central Hotel. **Your** rooms are ready.



Hans is happy. It is **his** birthday. He is with **his** friends Karen and Tia.



She is a scientist. **Her** job is interesting.



This is **my** apartment. **Its** windows are big and **its** walls are white.



We are in the sales department. **Our** office is in Paris.



Samantha, Robert and Olivier are architects. **Their** office is in Lisbon.
