Hello, **I** am Tony.

Definition

A pronoun replaces a noun: I, you, he, she, it, we, they

People			Things
I	he	we	it
you	she	they	they

Subject pronouns



I am Penelope. **I** am Spanish.



You are a colleague.



He is Jeremy.



She is a receptionist.



It is an aeroplane.



We are friends.



They are married.

Examples

I am Lisa. **I** am Scottish.

Hello **Kate**. Are **you** English?

Mike is American. **He** is from California.

Lucy is a doctor. **She** is at the hospital.

The **BBC** is a company. **It** is a British company.

Liz and I are colleagues. **We** are secretaries.

Max and Sue are married. **They** are from Liverpool.
