Quantifiers

Quantifiers are a kind of determiner. They can consist of a single word or a phrase. They are used with countable or uncountable nouns to give information about quantities or amounts. Here are some examples:

all	much	either	few	some	each
no	many	neither	little	any	every
none	a lot of	both	something	anyone	nowhere

Determiners

Determiners are used in front of nouns to give us more information. There are different kinds, including articles, numbers, demonstratives, quantifiers and possessive adjectives. For example:

I have two children. My daughter is six and my son is four.

I like this book; it has a lot of information about the city.
