Introduction



"I'd like some croissants, please." "Sorry, we don't have any today."

Definition

Some and any are quantifiers.

Construction

	Some	Any
Affirmative	I have some money.	×
Negative	×	I don't have any money.
Interrogative	Do you need some money?	Do you have any money?
Singular countable nouns	×	*
Plural countable nouns	We have some books.	We don't have any books.
Uncountable nouns	I need some information.	I don't have any information.

Use

We use some and any to talk about quantities and amounts - not large and not small.

Examples



She has some flowers.



He doesn't have any food.



Do you have any questions?
