Introduction



"I'd like **some** croissants, please." "Sorry, we don't have **any** today."

Definition

Some and **any** are quantifiers.

Construction

	Some	Any
Affirmative	I have some money.	✗
Negative	✗	I don't have any money.
Interrogative	Do you need some money?	Do you have any money?
Singular countable nouns	✗	✗
Plural countable nouns	We have some books.	We don't have any books.
Uncountable nouns	I need some information.	I don't have any information.

Use

We use **some** and **any** to talk about quantities and amounts - not large and not small.

Examples



She has **some** flowers.



He doesn't have **any** food.
